The 2018 Les Leçons des Maîtres is a serious wine, composed of 76% Sauvignon Blanc and 24% Sémillon. The nose is gorgeous, with aromas of warm peaches, white lilac, beeswax, dried hay, kiwi and hints of fresh tarragon. The medium-bodied palate is rounded and elegantly styled with understated flavors, bright freshness and a long finish. I suspect this will improve and gain nuance over the next 3-5 years in bottle.

Made of 100% Sauvignon Blanc, the 2018 Sauvignon Blanc Les Pierres Qui Décident has a bright nose of gooseberry, kiwi and lime peel with white peach, tarragon and crushed stone aromas. The palate is light-bodied, zesty and bright with citrusy flavors and a long, juicy finish.
