Current Releases from Sonoma with a Focus on 2022

One of the common themes in the resulting wines was that this vintage offers immediate appeal, with wide drinking windows, especially compared to the more structured 2021s. The aromatics lean toward attractive, fruit-driven profiles with savory nuances and approachable structures.



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Les leçons des maîtres

Made entirely from Sauvignon Blanc, the 2022 Les Leçons Des Maîtres pours a right straw/silver color and is zesty and focused in the glass, with a light lift of fresh white pepper, chives, white grapefruit, and just a hint of jalapeno that stays well in check. It's medium-bodied and more linear on the palate, with bright acidity, good concentration, and a long, clean finish. From a very cold site and aged in 100% new oak, it's going to drink well for several years to come. Drink 2024–2039.

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Les pierres qui décident

A bright straw color with a green tinge, the 2022 Les Pierres Qui Décident is fresh and tropical with refined aromatics of 20% Semillon, and has a bit of wet stone as well as notes of beeswax, preserved lemon, white grapefruit, tropical mango, and white currants. Medium-bodied, it has a great silky texture and refreshing, clean, ripe acidity through the long finish. It has the ability to age and is going to show its best over the next 6–7 years. Both of these wines are aged in 100% new oak, but neither feels that way.

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
