2023 Alma de Cattleya Rosé of Pinot Noir (Sonoma County):

An especially fresh and lively wine that was fermented on the lees for at least six months to gain more volume and nuances. It shows good, crunchy acidity and focused fruit notes on the medium to full body. Fresh raspberry, mineral, red cherry, and saline flavors and great tension in the texture. Drink now.

92 POINTS

2023 Alma de Cattleya Sauvignon Blanc (Sonoma County):

A snappy, zesty, medium-bodied wine with stony, flinty aromas, lively, lemon, and grapefruit pith flavors and great acidity that keeps it fresh. Fermented in natural French oak barrels and aged on the lees for six months before bottling. Drink now.

2023 Alma de Cattleya Chardonnay (Sonoma County):

A rather lean, racy, elegant wine that plays down the butter and toast qualities, and brings out the varieties notes of lemon curd, lime zest, cream, and minerals on a vivid, tangy texture. Full-body, but it feels light and very well balanced. Drink now or hold.

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2023 Alma de Cattleya Pinot Noir (Sonoma County):

Bright, balanced and delicious, with tempting, red and black cherry flavors and a lively, lightly tic texture. Subtle notes of cinnamon, star anise, and sour cherries keep your your interest through a fresh, lingering finish. Grapes are sourced from Sonoma Coast and Russian River appellations. Drink now.

2023 Alma de Cattleya Syrah (Sonoma County):

A suddenly structured and true type wine that's generous in blackberry, licorice and peppercorn flavors. Lightly chewy tannins and a full body, bring out the gorgeous flavors, with a smooth polish around the edges. Drink or hold.
